A court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st day of August
1810 this will was presented and read by Anthony Andrews and Jordan Coker
the Executors therein named proved by the oaths of Samuel White James
Washington and Joseph Freeman the witnesses thereto and ordered to be
recorded And on the motion of said Executors made call according
to Law certificate is granted showing for obtaining a probate thereof for
due form on their Oath and Sety whereas from the said Anthony
Andrews and Jordan Coker together with Lewis Branch and
Phadreck Bayless their self entered into and acknowledged a Bond in
the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the Law
directs.
