I give to my negro woman Judy my yearning bed quilt also to my negro woman Lucy my black spotted blanket also it is my desire that my negro man Elia may have a blanket made of the new yarn in the shop

It is my desire that the remainder of my late furniture be equally divided between my two grand daughters before named Rebecca Williams and Elizabeth Davis

I give to my grand daughter Peggy I Will my Looking glass and salt cellar and all my guns and provisions

I give to my grand daughter Elizabeth Williams my black shawl & her use

I give to Elyza W. Williams daughter of Williams Williams my green shawl about to my desire that all my silver articles be divided between Elyza W. Williams Mary I Will daughters of William Williams and Martha Williams daughter of William Williams

I give to Elyza Davis that has with me five dollars I do constitute and appoint my son in Law Wm. Williams Executor and William Williams Executor he that my last will and Testament is in writing and whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 22 day of August 1820 signed sealed and declared to be his last will and Testament in presence of
