At a Court held for the county of Southampton on the 17th day of July 1820
This Will was presented in Court by Joseph Gillman the said Thomas name
proved by the oaths of James Merrick and John Foster the witnesses thereto and
ordered to be recorded and on the motion of said Court was made out according to
Law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form
on his giving Bond and security whereupon the said Joseph Gillman together
with Edward Wm Henry W. Gillman and Joseph Harris his co-sureties
entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of fifty thousand dollars
conditions as the Law directs And at a Court held for the aforesaid county
on the 18th day of July 1820 Thomas Harris the above named Thomas name
appeared at Court and took upon himself the burden of the execution
thereof Whereupon the said Thomas Harris together with Henry W.
Gillman Edward Wm Henry W. Gillman and Joseph Harris his co-sureties entered into
and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of fifty thousand dollars conditions
as the Law directs

pennant and Doan) together with my Gigs and Harness to her and

I Give

unto my sister Martha Stewart during her life my negro man Solomon
when the said negro to belong to Mary Lewis Stewart to her and her
heirs forever

I Give

unto my daughter Mary Dyer Stewart daughter of Martha
Stewart the plantation wherein my father lived together with my
negro manly Quacks Anthony Black Kid and his children
to her and her heirs forever and my desire is that the said plantation
to be kept up with the negroes for the benefit of the said Mary D.
Stewart until she shall become of age of many years to her
and her heirs forever

I Give

unto my daughter Mary Dyer Stewart my negro girl Betty her and her
children if any to her and her heirs forever

I Give

unto my son James Williams son of James Williams
the plantation wherein I now live called Duckhorn plantation to him
and his heirs forever

I Leave

my barren plantation to be sold by my Executors to pay my
just debts

I Give

and bequeath unto Jacob Williams my half blooded Girl
Mary and her heirs forever

I Leave

my clothing to be equally divided between Richard C.
Harris and Anthony Stewart

Lastly

I nominate and appoint James Williams and Jacob Williams
