

Executed to this my last Will and Testament allowing them to place on the amount of account current a compensation for their trouble hereby revoking all other former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made or made by Whome I have heretofore set my hand and signed my seal this thirteenth day of September 1819 signed sealed published and declared and for the last Will and Testament of the above named James

At a Court of quarterly session continued and held for the County of Southampton on the 17th of November 1819 at writing purposing the last Will and Testament of James Wilson deceased the 13th day of September 1819 was this day presented in court by Drury Waller one of the Justices named as ordered to be proved and whereupon Richard Purcell by his attorney appears and affirms the proof of the said Will whereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined and the arguments of counsel on both sides fully heard on contention whereof it is the unanimous opinion of the court that the said James Wilson was at the time of executing the said Will of sound and disposing mind and memory and that he was under no undue influence whereupon the said writing was proved according to Law by the oath of Nathaniel Cummings, Geo Whitfield and Abner Williams the witnesses thereto Therefore it is ordered that the said writing be received as and for the last Will and Testament of the said James Wilson deceased

And at a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 18th of April 1820 this Will was presented in court by Drury Waller the Justices named who read the same according to their certificate is granted him for obtaining and a probate thereof and due form on his grant and Copy whereupon

First My Will and desire is that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate and also funeral expences

Then I then give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Patience Wade all my lands and tenements & that stock of all kinds after paying my just debts during her widowhood and if she survives before she departs this life then my desire is that all my property except my Land to be sold and divided among my children as follows

Then I give and bequeath unto William Wade one fourth of the money arising from the property to him and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto Gentry Lewis one fourth of the money arising from the property to him and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto Joshua Wade one fourth of the money arising from the property to him and his heirs forever

Then I give and bequeath unto Sarah Wade one fourth of the
