This writ was pursuant to Court process by the order of Matthew Gardner was ordered to be recorded Administrators with the writ annexed a grant to Susanna Bridger for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on her giving bond and security whereupon the said Susanna Bridger together with Jacob Gardner her security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs
