I lend to my daughter Elizabeth Adams at my dec-
dus one negro girl (Polly) and her increase during said Eliza-
beth's natural life also one cow in further kind and
provisions also one Loom all of which at her decease to be
equally divided amongst her heirs & son Benjamin included

I give and bequeath to my son Wm Adams the residue of my
property (provided he lives to his sister Elizabeth ten acres of land
during her natural life and at her decease give the same to her
heirs (her son Benjamin included) forever

I do hereby acknowledge and attest my son William Adams my
whole and sole Test to this my last will and testament
signed sealed and acknowledged in presence of me this 16th day of
April 1820
