 and one fifth part Mary Eliza Fort to them and their heirs forever
 And Lastly I do constitute and appoint Samuel Warham my Executor to this my
 Last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all other wills

 subscribed his name this twentieth day of February one thousand eight hundred & twenty
