In the name of God Amen I Robert Nicholson of the County of J^e Amptⁿ
and State of Virginia and parish of Saint Luke being sick but of perfect mind
Sense and memory thankes be to God for the same do make and ordain this
my last will and Testament in manner and form following Witness
I leave to my living wife during her natural life or widowhood the plantation
whereon I now live together with a sufficiency of the Crops of all Kind & and
sparks or bacone for their use for one year after four Head of Horses manly
The two carriage Horses the young bay mare and small sorrel Horse called Jack
also one yoke of oxen and two Head of cattle two choice Fifty Head of Hogs and twenty
Head of Sheep also one cart and wheel and one Horse cart and wheels three plows
granite also my Carriag^e and Turnip also Two Stills and all the household
belong^s to this plantation also the plantation mensels of every Kind
sufficient for her use also all the Game shot and Kitchen furnitures I also
leave to my living wife while my children become of age or marry
six negroes manly John Isaac Moses George Beck and Crispy My will is that
my children shall be bouned clothed and schooled until they become of
age or marry from the profits arising from the above mentioned bound^s prop-
erty my will and desire is that as my children manly Robert Nicholson fair
W Nicholson Sally R Nicholson George C Nicholson and Albert Nicholson because
of age or marry that the above mentioned bound^s six negroes be divided and each
of my above mentioned children takes their proportionable part to them and
their heirs forever

Item 2

I give and bequeath to my living wife all the property that she was
possessed with when I married her to her and her heirs forever
My will and desire is that all my personal estate not kept for trade loaned
or given away except negroes shall be sold on a credit of twelve months
and the money arising from the sale to be equally divided between
my children I manly Mary Ann Lucy Robert Nicholson Jane R
Nicholson Sally R Nicholson George C Nicholson and Albert Nicholson
to them and their heirs forever

Item 3

My will and desire is that the money that is due to my estate
be applied to the purpose of paying my just debts and if there shal^t not be
enough to pay my debts my Credit shall be at liberty to sell one or two of
my negroes manly Jack and Jeffray
My will and desire is that all my negroes not previously loaned or
given away in my will be sold with Robert Nicholson his executors
of age should be equally divided between my children manly Robert
Nicholson fair W Nicholson Sally R Nicholson George C Nicholson and Albert

Item 4
