In the name of God amen I Elizabeth Waper of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being of sound memory and mind do make and ordain this my last will and testament in the manner and form as follows to wit

Item 1st

I give unto my beloved wife mostly Waper during her life all my lands I also have with my self two negroes I also have during her life and one fourth of my stock of all Hens and one fourth part of my household and Kitchen furniture and one fourth of my plantation interests of every kind to her during her life

Item 2nd

I give and bequeath unto my son Miles Waper one tract of land on the South side of Quaquehanna Swamp beginning at the end of Swamp at a corner of Henry Wapers land thence after the said corner to an old dam thence from the South end of the dam the line shall run parallel with the Swamp to the outside boundaries to him forever

Item 3rd

I give and bequeath unto my son Elizabeth Waper one tract of land on the North side of the Quaquehanna Swamp which tract I divide by the aforesaid line I also give to my son Elizabeth Waper one tract of land on Black Creek Swamp to him forever

Item 4th

I give and bequeath to my son John Waper and James Waper the sum of twenty dollars each to be received out of my Estate

Item 5th

I also give to my son Miles Waper my title but I move over to him forever

Item 6th

I give and bequeath unto my son Elizabeth Waper all the residue of my estate after my just debts are paid and satisfied I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Elizabeth Waper Executor of this my last will and testament revoking and annulling all other wills or wills set forth by me or made in my life whereof I have heretofore set my hand and seal and do hereby affirm my seal this 10th day of July 1819 Signed Seals and

A Court held for the County of Southampton on the 10th day 1821 This will was presented in court by Elizabeth Waper the test. Thomas Adams sworn by the oath of John Beck and James Beck the witnesses and according to the oath of the test. the will was read according to law and the same was granted for obtaining a probate thereof in due form on his giving bond security whereupon the said Elizabeth Waper together with John Beck & James Beck his sons entered into and took a Bond in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs
