I give and bequeath unto my young wife Sally the following Articles and items
to wit All the corn that is in the ship with my wife's key One bed and furniture one soap
stick and blacke fiddler that is made at home one cross cut Saw one pair
of iron tongs One pair of flat irons One large fork One Dutch oven
One miller's foot One silver gaine basin one cut and 2 plates one flower
wheel One pair of glass backets two measuring horns one silver framed one
silver box 4 counter & jugs One brook silver ware all my bees cotton
to her and her heirs forever

And all the rest of my property is to be sold to pay my just debts
except my shoe makers tools which I give to James Gardner forever
I leave Joshua Gardner and his heirs be it at this my last will &
testament making all other wills or wills made or to be made by me or myself
thereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day of December 1821.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 10th December 1821 This
will was presented by Joseph Gardner one of the Executors thereof named
proved by the oaths of John Gardner the said executor and ordered to be
recorded and on the petition of said executor (who made oath according to
Law evidence is granted him for obtaining a writ therefor and for
an injunction King and Security Whereupon the said Joshua Gardner
together with John Gardiner and another Melians his Secuties
appeared into and acted a Plea in the penalty of five hundred dollars
conditioned as the Law directs
