In the name of God Amen I Sarah Combs of the County of Southampten being mad in body but of sound mind and memory and of disposing disposition do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following to wit

Item 1

I give Devise is that all my just debts should be paid of &c my death

Item 2

I give unto my dear Beloved Wife of Howell Bapstall of my personal Estate of what kind or sort soever to her and the heirs of her body forever

Lastly

I give unto said Beloved Wife the lands which my dear Beloved Son Combs left me in his last Will to her and the heirs of her body forever

I do hereby appoint my friend William Peters Executor of this my last Will and Testament as witness my hand and seal this third day of July 1815
