Sarson In the Name of God amen I John Vaughan of the county of Southampton and State of
 Virginia being full of sound and perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last
 will and Testament, in manner and form following to wit

First of all I desire that all my just debts and Burial charges be paid by my Executor
 hereafter named

Item I give and bequeath unto my son James Vaughan the Negroes Amos and Mah to him and his heirs
 forever should he arrive the age of twenty one years should he die before he should arrive to that
 age I desire the said Negroes to be divided between Sarah Vaughan Parson son of
 Matthew Parson and William Vaughan son of Edward Vaughan to be equally
 divided between them the said Parson and Vaughan also a tract of Corns purchased
 of Etheldred Newman I give to my son James & Vaughan in the same manner &
 form as above and should he die under the age of twenty one years I desire to
 the said Sarah & Vaughan and my son Vaughan to be equally divided between
 them also two pieces of land to him but should his grade mother live longer
 than him I desire she should have them also one two acres purchased in the
 same manner and form as the other property has been given
