In the name of God Amen I Daniel Boykin of the County of Southhampton and parish of Storroway being weak in body but of perfect sound mind and memory do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in manner and form following. I give and bequeath unto my wife Faitha Boykin the property as follows Vizt one Horse of first choice also one riding chain one negro girl named Cate one feather bed and furniture first choice two cows and calves three choice two chest two sows and pigs to her and her heirs forever. I also lend my wife the following property Vizt one negro man named Ben also the use of one half of the land and orchard belonging to the plantation wherein Simon his House and the large still that I shall hereafter devise unto my son Daniel Boykin

Give and bequeath unto my Son Daniel Boykin part of my plantation wherein I now
live. All the lands lying and being on the north side of the fore branch with
all the houses orchards and the largest still of the dividing line between my
two sons beginning at a cypress tree on the fore branch then up the said branch to the head
and from thence a straight course to Seths Mill Moulds dam. I also give unto my
son Daniel, Brightons the following slaves namely Holland Dick & Selby
One Horse two Cows and calves two sheep and pigs one feather bed and
