balance of my plantation not heretofore devised to my son Samuel Baykin
also the least stile also two hammers and fifty dollars to be raised out of my
estate for the purpose of raising building a dwelling house for my said son
John Baykin to him and his heirs forever the balance of my estate not herebefore
mentioned I wish sold and after my just debts are paid I wish to be equally
divided between my wife, John Baykin and my two sons to them and their heirs forever
I also appoint my friends David J. Baykin to be my whole and sole executor of the
my last will and Testament disannulling and making void all other wills by me
heretofore made In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 27th day

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 15 July 1822 This will was
presented in Court by David J. Baykin the adm^r executor therein named proved by
the oaths of John Crumpler and Solomon Pasture two of the witnesses here and ordered
to be recorded And at a Court held for the aforesaid County on the 19 Augt 1822
and on the motion of said Executor who made oath according to Law Certificate
is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on his giving bond &
Security Whereupon the said David J. Baykin together with James Buchanan
and Silas Sumnerall his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the
penalty of Ten thousand dollars Conditions as the Law directs

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my two nephews William Rochelle and John Rochelle all
the residue of my Estate both real and personal to be equally divided between them
to them and their heirs forever and lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my
friends Nathaniel Rochelle my whole and sole executor to this my last will & letters
ent. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
5th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
two
