 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12th day of Octr 1822

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st day of Octr 1822
 This will was presented in Court by Burwell Parrot the Exor therein named sworn
 by the oath of Sally P Parrot and Lucy Parrot two of the witnesses thereto &
 ordered to be recorded and in the motion of said Exor who made oath
 according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat
 thereof in due form on this giving Bond and Joties whereupon to the said Burw
 el Parrot together with Amos Simpson and James St Branch Esq Jcty
 entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars
 conditioned as the Law directs

I Peter Moore of Southampton County Virginia do make and ordain this my
 last will and testament in manner and form following
 First I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Gardner fifty acres of Land adjoining the
 Lands of her husband Salmon Gardner and the lands of John Daugherty estate
 to be cut off from my other Lands by a line to run across it in an east
 and west direction to her and her heirs and assigns forever
 Item I give to my Daughter Mary Moore one heifer - two and furniture on an
 and calf and one good Cotton Wheel to her and her heirs and assigns
 Item I give to my daughter Nancy Moore one bed and furniture one Cow and calf
 and one good Cotton Wheel in fee simple
 Item I give to my son James Moore in fee simple
 Item I give to my son John Moore one horse named Prince (now called Bud)
 one bed and furniture and one years schooling if there is a school kept
 convenient that he can go from home But if for want of such
 convenient School he should have to board out my Estate shall pay for
 his tuition only
 Item I leave all the residue of my Estate in the following manner to wit
 The Land and plantation during the life of widows of my wife
 Mary Moore to be occupied by my son James Moore for his and his
 mother's benefit that is to say he shall tend the plantation in any way
 that he may think proper in doing which he shall have the use of
 my two horses during the said term of his mother's life in widowhood
 and shall give to her each and every year on Christmas day the crop of
 every kind which he may raise on the Land he paying two thirds and
 she one third of the value of the said Land annually and my personal
