

estate not otherwise disposed of) after debts and funeral expenses are paid I leave to the use of my wife Mary Moore during her life in widowhood and on her death or marriage I give the said personal Estate including my personal Estate to be equally divided amongst my four children Mary Moore James Moore Stacey Moore and John Moore and on the death or marriage of my wife Mary Moore I desire that the said should be laid off into four lots of equal number of acres by lines to cropset in and east and westerly directions that one of the two Lots at the South end shall contain the kitchen and Barn and the other all the rest of the houses and that when thus laid off my son James shall take his choice and my son John Moore shall be entitled to the other and that each or either shall have the right to remove a house or houses to his own Lot so as to meet the intent and meaning of this clause and the remaining two Lots I give the one to my Daughter Mary Moore and the other to my Daughter Stacey Moore all which several lots are hereby given to my children as above mentioned and to them and their heirs forever and assigns forever

Item I hereby desire and it is to be clearly understood that my wife Mary Moore is to live in and enjoy the house and houses on my plantation unmolested during her life in widowhood with the privilege of keeping such of her children with her as may choose to continue with her

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my son James Moore and my son in Law Jason Gardner executors of this my last will and Testament hereby ratifying confirming and declaring this and no other to be my true last will and Testament In testimony whereof I the said Peter Moore have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12th day of Octr 1820
