In the name of God Amen I Sabitha Foulkes of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia living in good health at this time and
sound mind and memory thanks be to God for his mercies do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner following
Trust first of all I desire that all my debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged

I give my son John James his negro boy Peter and George

To my daughter Sabitha Foulkes my negro woman Lucy and her increase to her and her heirs forever

I give to my Grand Son James Johnson the son of Sabitha Johnson one negro boy named Coffy to him and his heirs forever
Lastly I nominate and appoint my friend Matthew Gardner my wife and sole executrix to this my last Will and
Testament of my possessions whereof I have set my hand and seal the 11th day of March 1819

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the day February 1823 Ours ^{testate} presented on behalf by Matthew Gardner the husbandman who refused to take upon him self
the burden of the execution thereof passed by the authority of Leonard Gardner and Phoebe Bradshaw
two of the subscribers that are named to be executors under the motion of Sabitha Foulkes for letters
of administration with the will annexed she same is granted her on her giving bond security
whereupon she said Sabitha Foulkes together with Matthew Gardner her security entered into
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the
same directs
