Secondly I give the balance of the before mentioned debt due me from Rich. Archibald to my Grand Children Martha M. Banks, James Banks and Benjamin Wilsons to be kept by them until their marriage. At which time they shall arrive at the age of twenty one years to them and their heirs forever.

I direct that the balance of my Estate of what ever nature or kind should be left, and out of the proceeds thereof first paying my General expenses and all my other just debts and the balance of any remaining out of such debts I give to my Grand Children Anna Thompson, Elizabeth Thompson, Joseph and Elizabeth Thompson to them and their heirs forever.

Thirdly I constitute and appoint Henry Applegate and William Gresham Executors to this my last will and Testament according to all other Just for them made & witnessed whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of February 1823.
