

1st I Give unto my Grandson Joseph State forty acres of Land to be laid off to the north side of the old plantations to him & his heirs forever
 2nd I Give unto my daughter Rebecca State the sum of five dollars
 3rd I Give unto my Grandson Simeon State the sum of Five dollars
 4th I Give unto my Daughter Kate Barker one Quaker bed and furnitures her bed and two bedsteads
 5th I Give unto my son Miles State all the rest of my lands and real and personal of my property of every kind whatsoever not heretofore given away out of which he is to pay all just debts to him and his heirs forever
 I do hereby constitute my son Miles State my only Executor to this my last Will & Testament and to keep all Wills and Testaments hereafter by me made until I am no more
 I have hereunto set my hand and advised my eld son 15th day of October 1722

At a Court held for the County of Grandampson on the 17 May 1823 The Well known Presales in Court by John Davis Esq. took place and with the sanction of the Justices thereof Sundry Statute the two thousand named persons by refusing to qualify proved by the oaths of John Davis Solomon Byler and William Percy the Attorneys at Law and ordered to be removed and on the motion of John Davis Esq. money was paid according to Law. Whereupon was granted them for obtaining a probate thereof as was shown on the going bond and Security taken upon the said John Davis together with Abraham Williams and William Percy the Secutaries entered into and authorized them bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars Conditioned as the Law directs

Marcell Turner in his death bed requested that after his just debts had paid out of his Estate that Melchor Palmer should have five hundred dollars of his said Estate after the said five hundred dollars had been paid to the balance of his personal and real Estate to his beloved Sister Sally Turner after said Sally Turners death of she did without marriage to go to Benjamin Turners children as Successors of Turner Sweden and Nathaniel Ines

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the January 1823. The honorable's Court of Charles Sumner was present in Court and pronounced and established as the last Will and bequeathed to be recorded and in the Court of Benjamin Turner five letters of administration on his Estate the same is granted them on the giving bond and giving Oath for the said Benjamin Turner together with John A. Turner and Henry Porter his Securities before said Court and acknowledged their said as the County of Southampton dollars and pence as the Law directs

I Elizabeth Ballou of the County of Southampton do hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner & form following that is to say first I declare that my whole Estate Slaves and other personal estate may be sold by my executor hereafter named and that paying out of the moneys arising therefrom all my just debts & funeral or burial expences Secondly After the payment of my just debts and funeral expences my desire is that the remainder of the said of my Estate together with said debts as may be due in respect what may be due on loan from my daughter Eliza A. Colburn which I do hereby discharge her from the payment of provided she does not may not be requested for the payment of my debts may be divided into three equal parts to be distributed in the following manner viz I give one part to my daughter Mary Ann Davis one part to my daughter Eliza A. Colburn and the remaining one third part it is my desire may remain in the hands of my executor hereafter named to be by him applied in such manner and in such proportions from time to time as he may think proper to the support of my son Thomas H. Colburn and my Grandson Benjamin C. Colburn son of Thomas H. Colburn shall arrive to the age of twenty one years at which time it is my desire he may have whatever may be remaining of the said one third part of my Estate and the Funds of my Executors and Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Henry Briggs executor of this my last will and Testament being with him all other and former wills or Testaments by me made I witness above I have hereunto signed and affixed my seal this day of the year 1831 signed sealed published given and for the last will and Testament of this Mrs. named Elizabeth Ballou.
