- I give to my son Samuel Harrison five negroes, Hans, Ned, Woman, Abby, and Miss Mary, Ray, Henry, and Harriette and one feather bed and furniture and after the death of my wife I also give my said son Samuel & Harrison two other negroes, John and an old Pruss together with the future increase of the negroes above mentioned to him and his heirs and assigns forever
- I give to my son Edwin Harrison five negroes, two old slaves, George, Tom, and Mary, Grace, John, Harry, by Jacob and Luc, Henry, and one feather bed and furniture and after the death of my wife I give to my said son Edwin Harrison two other negroes, Boy, Luke, and Geo. Apphia together with the future increase of the negroes above mentioned to him and his heirs and assigns forever
- I give to my son William Harrison five negroes, by a slave Arthur, Woman, and Mary, John, Beate, and Martha, and boy, Madelon and one feather bed and furniture and after the death of my wife I also give to my said son William Harrison three other negroes, to wit, Man, Abram, Woman, Han, and Luc, to be sold together with the future increase of the negroes above named to him and his heirs and assigns forever
- I give to my son George Harrison and Washington, D. C. I give in equal divisions one negro, Girl, Lotty, with the future increase to them and their heirs and assigns forever
- At the death of my wife I give unequal division to my four children, Samuel & Harrison, Edwin, and William Harrison, five negroes, Hans, Harriet, and Geo. together with the future increase together with all my lands, hold, and children, furniture, and plantation interests and stock, all which I have lent to my wife during her life to them and their heirs forever
- I give to my wife Temperance Harrison one third part of the bacon or pork that I may have on hand at my death
- I have all the residue of my estate of every kind and quality to be sold at the discretion of my Executors and Executors hereafter to be named and the money arising therefrom together with what may be collected from those indebted to me except what is before given to my wife after the payment of my just debts I give in equal division to my four children, Samuel, C. Harrison, Susan, Edwin, and William Harrison to them and their heirs forever

Lastly I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife Temperance, she wife and my children, Samuel, C. Harrison, Edwin, and William Harrison, sole Executors and Administrators of this my last Will and Testament hereby ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In testimony whereof I the said Samuel Harrison have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 24th day of September 1823

At a Court held for the County of Somerset on the 20th October 1823. This Will was presented in Court by Edwin and William Harrison two of the Executors therein named Temperance Harrison the Executrix and Samuel C. Harrison another executor therein named refusing to take any part of the execution thereof proved by the oaths of Jacob Darden and Edwin G. Hunt two of the witnesses thereto and ordered as is recorded And as the motion of the said Edwin who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on their giving bond of security whereupon the said Edwin and William Harrison together with Joseph Parker Patrick Gales and James. I do hereby certify their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of fifteen thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs
