I give and bequeath unto my wife Rhoda all and every part of my estate after paying all my just debts
to her and her heirs forever. I also do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Samuel Eller son my
eldest and sole executor to this my last will and testament hereby making and remitting all my
other wills or testaments hereof by me made heretofore witness I Will. Jordan have signed to this my hand
and affixed my seal this the fourth day of October 1823. Signed sealed published and made known to my

Samuel Eller the Executor whom names who refusing to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof
providing by the oath of William Ferguson Jr and Joe Whifford two of the trustees thereon and ordered to be
recited and on the motion of Rhoda Jordan for her administration such the will and the same
is granted her and her giving bond and security whereupon the said Rhoda Jordan together with Emma
Tuck and John Ferguson has securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
five hundred dollars conditioned as the said will.
