**Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Zebulon Lewis taken the 8<sup>th</sup> January 1824.**

First ploughing took place 5 days after sowing and continued until the 20th of October, when the ground was in good condition for sowing. The first sowing was done on the 21st of October, and the last on the 25th. The sowing was done in rows 18 inches apart, and each row contained 10 seeds. The seed was sown at a depth of 1 inch. The soil was well prepared before sowing, and the ground was kept moist throughout the period of sowing. The plants grew well, and the yield was good.
