In the name of God Amen I Howell Scarborough of the County of Southampton being in a weak state
of health but in my perfect senses do make this my last will and testament in the following manner
and form

- Item 1st I do give unto my beloved wife Sarah Scarborough during her natural life or widowhood
the following negroes to wit Daniel Sr. Nath. Eby and Harriett together with all my household and
kitchen furniture and plantation utensils also my crop of every description that I may have on hand
or growing on my plantation at the time of my death also such furniture and deas in specie as shall be laid
on for the use of my family also the whole of my stock of all kinds. I also lend unto my wife Sarah Scarborough
during her natural life or widowhood all my lands with the appurtenances therunto belonging on the north side
of the road estimated at one hundred and fifty acres the same more or less. The property above lent to my wife
during her natural life or widowhood I desire may be considered in lieu of dower
- Item 2^d I desire that should we have many lands or accout to I may have on hand after my just debts are paid bequeath
to my beloved wife in fee simple to her and her heirs forever
- Item 3^d At the death or marriage of my wife Sarah Scarborough I give the lands which I have before lent to
my wife during her natural life or widowhood unto my son William Scarborough together with my land on
the south side of the road supposed to be two hundred and fifty four and be the same more or less to him
and his heirs forever
- Item 4th I lend to my Grand daughter Temperance Ramsay during her natural life the following negroes to wit
Marian, Mandy and Patsy together with their increase
- Item 5th I desire my Grand daughter Temperance Ramsay should die having no lawful heir of her own body
my desire is that the negroes Marian, Patsy and Mandy with their increase may be divided to be an
equally divided between my four children
- Item 6th I lend unto my Daughter Mary Ramsay during her natural life the following negroes to wit
Amy, Violet and Corey with their increase provided the said Mary Ramsay should die having
my lawful heir of her own body my desire is that the said negroes be by my Will to
Corey and their increase returns and be equally divided between my four children Egal, Prudence
Scarborough, Fanny Holt and Priscilla Sumner to them and their heirs forever
- Item 7th I desire that the balance of my negroes not before called away may be divided into two equal parts
one of which I give unto my son Egal Scarborough to him and his heirs forever and other fifth part
I give unto my son William Scarborough to him and his heirs forever the other three parts to my
Daughter Fanny Holt Priscilla Sumner and Mary Ramsay I lend to them I give to their heirs forever
- Item 8th My four my four legans just above mentioned I desire to be divided and equally divided by my friends
Mellic, Hannah Davis, Anson, Benjamin Turner and James Satterton
- Item 9th My desire is that the negroes Daniel Sr. Nath. Eby and Harriett which I have before lent
unto my wife during her natural life or widowhood may at her death or marriage be equally divided
between my four children Egal and William Scarborough, Fanny Holt, Priscilla Sumner and Mary
Ramsay in the same manner and way as I have in the clause immediately above this divided
the negroes before this will being to be divided
- Item 10th I desire that the person at which I have before lent my wife Sarah Scarborough during
her natural life or widowhood may at her death or marriage be sold and the money equally divided
between my four children to them and their heirs forever
- Item 11th Lastly I do hereby constitute my son Egal and William Scarborough executors to
my last will and testament according to others her before by me made
