Item. I have my other property to be sold to pay my just debts and out of them should be any thing left for it to be Equally divided between all my children

I leave my house, farm, stock, Turner my whole and sole executor of this, my last will and testament, made by me. I do hereby set my hand and fix my seal this 3rd day of August in the 4th year of our Lord Christ 1824
 in presence of us Samuel Turner Nathan Turner

Also sent late for the County of Dorchester on the 30th Sept 1824. The same was presented in Court in
Evening Term the 1st October next and proved by the oath of Samuel Turner and Nathan Turner the deponents
before and ordered to be recorded on the motion of the said Esquire who made oath according to Law Art. 19 of the
Statute in obtaining a probate thereof in form on his being sworn by whom for the said Esquire Turner and John
Turner, James and Nathan Turner his Executors and next and sole Administrators in the hands of an Attorney
at Law. Ordered as the Law directs.
