Testimony

I do declare my name of Jas. Farmer of Southampton County and birth of 30th May 1797, in  
this body, under sound mind and memory thank his to almighty God for the same as made and ordain that he leave my  
last will and testament in manner and form following.

I give and bequeath to my loving wife Almira Farmer or her Chancery feather bed and furniture one set and six pugs  
Four sheets one Cow her choice one small pot and dutch oven one pewter dish and basin and all my clothes  
One Springing colt and potash and Corn to support her the year 1825. My plantation and not to be  
interfered with during her natural life and then to Jonathan Turner to have and hold her forever.

I have my other property to be sold to pay my just debts and if there should be any thing left for it to be  
equally divided between all my children.

I leave my Estate to my wife Almira Farmer my whole and sole Executrix of this my last will and testament made  
by me. I do hereby set my hand and seal my seal this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord Christ 1824  
in presence of my children Samuel Farmer Jonathan Turner
