In the name of God amen. I John Underwood of the County of Northampton do hereby make and ordain this writing to be my last will and testament & declaring all other wills by me herebefore made to be null & void I give devise and bequeath unto my son Thomas Underwood all the lands & tenements of the late estate of William Alsop late husband of Elizabeth Alsop of Chesham in the County of Bucks and plantations within the same lands and all its appurtenances and the following slaves to wit: Sarah, Mary, Anthony, Douglas, Henry, Abner, Benjamin, Henry, Martha, Ann, Edy, Peter and Anne above born of late Charles Alsop Esq. and also my wife and wife of late Charles Alsop Esq. and also one half and fourmors of his share in large still and some more in the plantation where I live to him and his heirs forever but on such condition that he should die without having a legitimate child or children at the time of his death then I give and bequeath all the lands herebefore given devised and bequeathed to him to to my Grandson Henry Biddle and Samuel Bryant or such of them as may survive my said son Thomas take equally in and take his share

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Turner the following slaves to wit: Hannah, Mary, Maria, Peter, John, Mary, Mary, Mary and John and their future increase to her and her heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Bryant the following slaves to wit: Mary, and her infant child Ophelia and my Son Jacob Maltby, Mary, Grace, Mary and Anne and their future increase to her and her heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Smith five hundred dollars to be raised out of my estate and also one half of such which she is against William Smith for the sum of ten hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Peggy Townsend one thousand dollars each to be raised out of my estate to her and her heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto Edm. and Underwood son of William Underwood one acre by name of Malt to him and his heirs forever but on such condition that the said Edm. and Underwood should die under the age of twenty one years without having a legitimate child or children at the time of his death then I give devise and bequeath the said acre by Malt to my four children namely Thomas Underwood, Martha Turner, Lucy Bryant, Lucy Smith and Peggy Townsend to them and their heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto Peggy Underwood daughter of Jacob Underwood one hundred dollars in cash to be raised out of my estate but on such condition that the said Peggy Underwood should die under the age of twenty one years without having a legitimate child or children at the time of her death then I give devise and bequeath such part of the said one hundred dollars which may not be expended for the necessary support and education of said Peggy Underwood at the happening of such event to my four children namely Thomas Underwood, Martha Turner, Lucy Bryant, Lucy Smith and Peggy Townsend to be equally divided to them and their heirs forever

Item It is my will and desire that my two negroes Tobias, Robt. Lucy, Henry and Daniel should remain on the plantation where I now live under the control and management of my son Thomas so long as they may live and after they become chargeable to my will and desire that they be comfortable supported by my son Thomas out of that part of my estate before given to him and I do hereby request my son Thomas to pay particular attention to their comfortable maintenance and support so long as they may live

Item It is my will and desire and I hereby direct my Executors hereafter named to make title of my tract of land in the north side of Stoney River near Jerusalem on such and as they may think most advisable and except a deed of one acre to the purchaser or purchasers thereof and I do hereby also direct my Executors to make title of all the rest and residue of my estate of what nature or kind soever not already given away and out of the proceeds of such title first pay & satisfy the before mentioned legacies and the surplus money arising from such sales after paying the before said legacies I give devise and bequeath unto my four children namely Thomas Underwood, Martha Turner, Lucy Bryant, Lucy Smith and Peggy Townsend to be equally divided between them and their heirs forever

Item I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son Thomas Underwood and my friend Samuel Biddle Esq. my Executors to this my last will and testament ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 10th day of June in the year of our Lord 1784 and of our Independence the 14th
