

I John Underwood of the County of Southampton do make this writing as and for a testament to the purpose
 one last will and testament in manner and form following to wit. Whereas in the foregoing last will and
 testament I gave to my daughter Martha Turner several shares, portions in the said will and also gave her an
 interest in some other legacies in the said will since making of which said will the said Martha Turner
 hath requested this life having an infant daughter named Nancy Lewis Turner. I do therefore hereby revoke
 so much of the foregoing last will and testament as relates to my said daughter and the same is hereby man-
 nule and void as touching my said daughter Martha Turner and I do hereby give and dispose of that part
 of my Estate heretofore given her with following manner to wit First I give devise and bequeath
 to the said Nancy Turner daughter of Edmund and Martha Turner the following negroes and negroes
 Maria Tichet and Julia her and her heirs forever but as can the said Nancy Lewis Turner
 shewed die without having a legitimate child or children at the time of her death then I give devise
 and bequeath the said negroes Lucy Maria Tichet and Julia and their increase to my four children
 namely Thomas Underwood Dorey Bryant Lucy Smith and Peggy Simmons to them their heirs forever
 Secondly I give devise and bequeath unto my son Thomas Underwood the following negroes which were heretofore
 given to my daughter Martha Turner to wit Joe Rice Amy and her infant child Sam and as to
 to him my said son Thomas and to his heirs forever and I direct him the making of the forego-
 ing will I have purchased several shares to wit Nelson. I therefore give devise and bequeath the said
 negro man Nelson to my daughter Dorey Bryant to her and her heirs and assigns forever
 And whereas also I have purchased other negroes since the making of my said last will to wit
 to wit Top and Wren I therefore give devise and bequeath the said negroes I purchased to my
 son Thomas Underwood to him and his heirs forever. I also give devise and bequeath unto
 my said son Thomas Underwood one negro boy child named Charles to him and his heirs forever
 I give and bequeath to my daughter Dorey Bryant one negro girl child Prudence to her and her heirs forever
 All the rest and residue of my Estate not heretofore disposed of I give devise and bequeath to my four
 children namely Thomas Underwood Dorey Bryant Lucy Smith and Peggy Simmons to them and
 their heirs forever In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 3^d
 day of February 1823 signed published and declared as and for
 the Codicil to the foregoing will in presence of
 Richard Searcy Jacobus Emelius *Ty*

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 26th June 1824. This will was presented in Court by
 James Nicholls one of the Executors therein named. Thomas Underwood the other one therein named refusing
 to take upon himself any part of the burden of the Execution thereof sworn by the testator And also sworn
 that for the aforesaid County of Southampton on the 1st Oct. 1824. The said Nicholls was sworn by the oath
 of freeman &c. one of the judges thereof and ordered to be received and on the motion of the said
 James Nicholls who made oath according to Law Certificate was granted him for obtaining a
 probat thereof in due form on his giving bond and security whereupon the said James Nicholls
 together with Clements Nicholls John Thomas and John Webb his heirs etc. entered into and
 solemnly sworn that in the presence of twenty five thousand dollars and also as the Law
 directs

In the name of God Amen this 9th of August 1824. I William Ramsey of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia being in perfect mind and sound memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of life
 and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain that to be my last
 will and testament availing and disannulling all other former wills and legacies given to this
 and date above written In the first place I give and recommend any debts ~~to~~ into the
 hands of God that pass all and as to my body to be buried in the earth in a Christian like
 and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors or friends and as touching such worldly
 goods I bequeath what hath pleased God to bestow upon me in this world I give devise & bequeath
 of the same in an answer and form following to wit after all my just debts & personal expenses
 or are paid

In the first place I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Ramsey one third
 part of my land whereon I now reside and my her natural life or in 30 years
