I Joseph Hart of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia hereby of sound mind and memory do hereby make and constitute this writing to be my last will and testament in manner and form following hereby giving all power, title or testaments by me made 1823

1st I desire that all my just debt do paid 2^d I should unite my loving wife, Lavinia Hart and my Mr. Single like the wife of all my Estate both real and personal of whatever nature or kind it may be

3rd All my Estate real or personal I give the whole of my Estate to my Three children viz To James Hart to Joseph Hart and to Mary Hart to be equally divided between them I give the same to them and their heirs forever

4th I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Lavinia Hart my whole and sole Executor to this my last will and testament do Witness my hand and seal this 13 day of August 1824 Signed Sealed and attested in presence

A Court held for the County of Southampton on the 21st December 1824 This will was presented to the Lavinia Hart the Executive there named refusing to qualify as such proved by the oath of John P. Pleasant and John E. Saddle two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of James C. Bailey for administration with the will annexed the same is granted him for obtaining a probate of it on his giving bond and security whereupon the James C. Bailey together with Mr. E. Bailey and John Holliman his Secunders entered into and affixed a Bond in the pen and ink of fifteen hundred dollars and should in the Court records

2nd My will and desire is that at the death or marriage of my wife Prudence that the above named property to be equally divided between my two daughters viz Mary Ann Margaret and Prudence Horn to them and their heirs forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of September in the year of our Lord 1824 Signed Sealed and attested in presence of
