In the name of God amen I Samuel Davidson of the County of Southampton and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five being of sound mind and perfect sense and memory sheweth before the Almighty God and concerning the sum total of his goods and property that into the hands of the Almighty God and for what worthy objects he hath granted the almighty to help him with his Grace and favors and dispose of as follows viz

I give unto my daughter Margaret Kieffer of Southampton County one bed to chest trunks one Wash-
tine plates one Spoon to be used her hair forever, I give my will and appoint that she shall depose and
property enough lots at any debt to pay my just debts and the balance of my estate both real and
personal I leave unto my wife by and Executors during her life as a comfort for the benefit of raising
my children containing one hundred acres of land more or less cattle hogs bees and furniture Christy I do
give chest trunks tables desks and some Earthen Ware and Clap ware 10th 1/2 lbs and after the
death of my wife Lydia I leave unto my son James Warden of Southampton County
One hundred acres of land more or less one bed and furniture one fine chest one stool one
Pewee Case and lots of every description to him forever I also give my daughter Martha
Warden of Southampton County one bed and furniture one hair comb one towel what one
Linnen what one comb to her and her heirs forever I also give my daughter Christy Warden
the balance of my House hold and Kitchen furniture not mentioned to her forever
Lastly I do nominate and appoint my friend Charles E. Potts of Southampton County my Heir
and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and that I do descend and make void
all other former wills or Testaments heretofore by me made I Witness where of I have
assisted with my hand and give my seal this 2^d day of October 1824

At a Court held for the County of Andover on the 1st January 1838 This will was presented to Court by Charles P. Veto R. Esquire whose name joined by the estates of Sime Ward, Charles Bradshaw and Robert September the respective heirs and assigns to be record and on the motion of the said Esquire who made oath according to due certificate so granted him for obtaining a probat thereof on due form on his giving bond of Security whereupon the said Charles P. Veto together with William Sales and James Standish his co-executors entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the said will directs

Noted. In the name of His amen. I have read Vision of the King of Siam and also of Oregon some time ago. I have not read and do not read in manner and form as follows: first

1st My wife and desire is that my Executor ^{hereafter named to be named} should receive and sell my Estate as well as sufficient to pay all my just debts and funeral Expenses 2nd After the payment of my just debts and funeral Expenses I give to my son Abner Thayer the sum of one dollar to him and his heirs forever 3rd I give to my son John Thayer the sum of one dollar to him and his heirs forever 4 I give to my son William Thayer the sum of one dollar to him and his heirs forever 5 I give to my hand daughter Sarah Thayer one hundred dollars to be received of my Estate which I give to her and her heirs forever 6th I give to my Grandson Simeon Thayer after paying the above legacies the whole of my Estate of what nature or kind I ever stand in debt of to him and his heirs forever provided he maintains and supports my daughter Annals Thayer during her natural life 7th Should my Grandson Simeon Thayer not deem proper to receive the above legacy for the care of himself and for the purpose of maintaining and supporting my daughter Annals Thayer then and in that case I give the said legacy to my said Son William Thayer. After the above legacies are paid lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear old William T Smith Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other former wills or Testaments by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirteenth day of November in our second
