At a Court held for the County of Somkampson on the 21<sup>st</sup> March 1821 This Will was presented in Court by Samuel Brown one of the Testators above named proved by the oaths of Samuel Gray and Thaddeus Vaughan two of the subscribers thereto and caused to be sworn Jacob Darden Sophia Darden John Thomas and James D. Mayfording the other Executors therein named and upon their oaths repeating to each other themselves any part of the substance of his execution thereof And as the subscriber of the said Edward Brown who made each according to law affidavit or granteth him full power after his decease to give and bequeath unto the said Son of Brown with Samuel D. Thomas his attorney entered into our acts & a Power in the penalty of Two thousand dollars Condition as the law directs

Date: January 26<sup>th</sup> 1821

In witness whereof I Martha Hill being of sound mind and perfect memory do make and ordain this writing as and for my last will and Testament in manner and form following

First I give my desire that my just debts Doctors accounts and funeral Expenses shall be paid out of my Estate items I give unto my Brother John A. Hill all the residue of my Estate after paying just debts to him before he dies unpaid and satisfaction of every kind both real and personal in case he shall live to the age of Ninety years or shall have an use of his body longifying together but if he should die under the age of Ninety one year unburdened law full heir of his body I then give and bequeath the whole of my Estate as aforesaid to him alive in Virginia as North Carolinian unto my friend Col. Thorpe this to him and his heirs forever

And Lastly I Constate and afform my friend Patrick Ross Executor of this my last Will & Testament to be making any other Will before by me made Interimmy writing I have set my hand and seal

At a Court held for the County of Somkampson on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 1821 This Will was presented in Court by the oaths of Thomas Gray one of the subscribers thereto and attested and proved by the same Court held for the aforesaid County on the 21<sup>st</sup> March 1821 This Will was further and fully proven by the oaths of John C. Penruddick Edg. Party the other subscribers thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of Patrick Ross the Executor thereon was a color made oath according to law testifying as granted him for giving a probate thereof in due form on his young sons and daughter wherupon the said Patrick Ross together with Emma Gray and Martha Ross his daughters witness unto and attest this day in the penalty of Two thousand dollars Condition as the Law directs

The Writen In the name of God amen the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord 1821 I Thomas Witten of Somkampson County being of sound memory and in good health thanks be to the Almighty God and calling to remembrance the uncertain Estate of this transitory life and that all flesh must yield unto death when it shall please God to call me to His Constitute and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following reciting and avowing by these presents all and every Billment and Testamente Will and Wills heretofore by me made and declared either by word or writing and this writing to be taken for my last will and Testament and no other

Item I leave my beloved wife among my lands during her life or widow hood also land her one negro man named Wall one bed and furniture house hold and Kitchen furniture for her family to enjoy common belonging necessary aply to her own use also one Cow and several more and one San Spanish

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Joshua Witten all my slaves lying on the South side of the Branch below my House also I give him one Cow one Bed Furniture & his horses forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Christopher Witten my lands on the North side of the Branch also one Cow one Bed Furniture to him this here forever
