Charley Eliza and bequeathed unto my Brother Ebenezer Eliza my niece Mary Ack and woman Hannah and all the balance of my Estate not heretofore given away in his paying to my Brother Ebenezer Eliza the sum of one hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever I do hereby constitute and appoint Elias Sumner my Executor to this my last Will and testament revoking all former Wills by me made heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 16th day of November 1826

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 19th June 1828 This Will was presented and Court by Elias Sumner the Executor named therein proved and sworn to be true and in the nature of the said Executor who made oath according to Law and gave him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on his giving bond for the same the said Elias Sumner with together with James P. Maguire and John P. Bapst his Securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars Conditional as the Law directs
