Will

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In the name of God amen I Sophia Tonell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being sick and weak
make of body but of a sound and perfect memory thanks be to God for the same and knowing the mortality of my self
and certainty of death and knowing that it is appointed for all mortals once to die do make and execute this my last
will and testament in form and manner as follows. First I recommend my soul to God who gave it and my
body to the grave to be buried in a Christian manner and as my immobility gives me let this pleane God
to help me with I heartily despoile of them in the following manner. Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my Brother James Tonell all the lands that I purchased
of Johnathan C. Whitcher and the said James Tonell to pay unto George Tonell one hundred dollars
the said lands to the said James Tonell his heirs and assigns forever. Item 2nd I give and bequeath
to Sally Tonell a nego boy named Ben to her and her heirs forever. Item 3rd I give unto Robert
Davis a nego girl Abby during her natural life and of she dies after her decease to the
said Robert Davis if two has she said nego I give to them forever more of provided she dies without
a lawful issue it is my will and desire that the said nego Abby and her executors to be equally divided
amongst my other beloved children. Item 4th It is my will and desire that all the residue of my Estate
after paying all my just debts shall equally divide between my beloved children. Item 5th James Tonell in
William Tonell and Elizabeth Hatch Sartly Appoint George Tonell my whole and sole Executor
to this my last will and Testament according all rules or Testaments made and made by me
and I nominate and command him to be my sole executors of this my last will and Testament this 23rd day of August 1825
or the same day I affix my hand and seal to these presents

Williamson the sum of One hundred dollars also my Beddell and Kettle. Item 2nd I give to my sisters
Poly Petrey and Rebecca Williamson each the sum of Five hundred dollars. Item 3rd I give the
residue or balance of my Estate to my Brother Arthur Williamson Sartly I nominate and
appoint my Brother Arthur Williamson my Executor to this my last will and testament written &
signed this 8th day of July 1825

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 19th September 1825 This
Will was presented in Court plaine by the oaths of James Myrick & Tonell two
of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recordes Arthur Williamson the Executor named in
said Will having fully died on the motion of Benjamin Williamson who made and
according to Law certificate to set the will ase and grants him on his young
son and heir whom in the said Benjamin Williamson with Thomas
& Clements Joseph Hump and James Myrick his secretaries entered into &
ack'd a bond on the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs
