1804 of Bradshaw In the name of God Amen I Benjamin Bradshaw of Southampton County and parish of  
Hillsborough being weak in body but of sound mind & memory do hereby certify to make this writing  
as and for my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows to wit

I send unto my beloved wife Mary Bradshaw all my lands that I am possessed of, with  
 my four Mills I Bradshaw shall arrive to the age of twenty one years or at which time I  
 wish my wife to have one third part assigned to her as well for her dower on the same  
 I also bear unto my wife the following negroes George Harry Valance Lundy Liza  
 Pether Miller Lydia Sophia and Nancy which are all that I have in my possession  
 I also send her at the death of my Mother here of 1734. also all my stock of all kind  
 together with my house hold and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils all which I  
 love unto my Wife so long as she remains my widow or until my Son William arrives  
 to twenty one years at which time I wish a division to take place amongst my three  
 children in the following manner

I give and bequeath unto my son William Bradshaw his share of my land at the decease of the aged  
Isabel. One share of my wife's share marry as soon after as convenient and the other one share along  
with the said also the following negroes Mary Kate and Liza one silver watch and one still pot life  
and towns also one share part of the command of Stock Anne's bed & kitchen furniture & plate and linen cloths  
to them and the heirs forever

From Igloo and bequest into my daughter's hands. I had the following negroes: a negro woman, John and Lydia. At the time my son Miles arrived to nearly six years ago, all on this of my stock, horse, tools and kitchen furniture and plantation, about 1000 and 1000.

Some and beautiful made my daughter Miss Bradshaw the following Negroes Wingo Calow  
Nobler Sophia and Wmmy for her to receive the benefit of at the time my son comes to  
marry. On June 23<sup>rd</sup> also on this part of my Black Man, Gold and Silver furniture and  
Manufacture presents it to her and her heirs forever

My Will and desire is that as much of my Stock as can be best spared shall be sold for the purpose of paying my just debts

My will and desire is that if I should ever happen that my wife or part to her should as a wife  
within that the equal possession of the property given to my children may be subject to the estate  
and I desire the party concerned to consult and appoint one friend to represent  
as my whole & full will to this my last will and testament revoking all other wills made  
by me since the 10th of March 1791 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 25th day of  
August 1791 at New York
