 and of Zedekiah Lewis decd and as administrator of Benjamin Lewis decd who was
 executor of Zedekiah Lewis decd's will at the same time as he has done that he show what
 debts he paid what amount he has received what were the profits and expenditures
 upon the plantations and slaves which have been kept up by him since the death of the
 said Zedekiah Lewis and report the same to the Court together with any matter or thing
 thought pertinent by himself or otherwise to be stated by the parties In order to a final
 decree
